## **CODE OF CONDUCT SUMMARY**

### **STUDENT RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

It is the goal of the Little Flower UFSD to educate students to their potential. In order to do this effectively, each member of the school community is expected to treat all others with dignity and respect.

A discipline policy has been developed with this goal in mind. It includes a description of the rights and responsibilities of students, as well as a code for student behavior.

### **STUDENT DRESS CODE:**

All students are expected to give proper attention to personal cleanliness and to dress appropriately for school and school functions. **Students along with his/her parent or cottage staff have the primary responsibility for acceptable student dress and appearance.** Teachers and all other district personnel should exemplify and reinforce acceptable student dress and help students develop an understanding of appropriate appearance in the school setting.

A student's dress, grooming and appearance, shall:

Be safe, appropriate and not disrupt or interfere with the educational process.

Include footwear at all times. Footwear that is a safety hazard will not be allowed.

Not include items that are vulgar, obscene or libelous, or denigrate others on account of race, color, religion, creed, national origin, gender, sexual orientation or disability.

Not promote and/or endorse the use of alcohol, tobacco or illegal drugs, and/or encourage other illegal or violent activities.

Recognize that revealing garments are not appropriate.

### **PROHIBITED STUDENT CONDUCT:**

The Board of Education expects all students to conduct themselves in an appropriate and civil manner, with proper regard to the rights and welfare of other students, district personnel and other members of the school community, and for the care of school facilities and equipment.

The best discipline is self-imposed, and students must learn to assume and accept responsibility for their own behavior, as well as the consequences of their misbehavior. District personnel who interact with students are expected to use disciplinary action only when necessary and to place emphasis on the student's ability to grow in self-discipline.

The Board recognizes the need to make its expectations for student conduct while on school property or engaged in a school function specific and clear. Students who will not accept responsibility for their own behavior and who violate school rules will be required to accept the penalties for the conduct.

Students may be subject to disciplinary action, up to and including suspension from school, when they engage in conduct that is disorderly or insubordinate, disruptive, violent or endangers the safety, moral, health or welfare of others.

Take the Long Island Expressway to Exit 68 North (William Floyd Parkway); Take William Floyd Parkway (North) all the way to the end (about 6 miles). At the end of William Floyd Parkway, make a right turn onto route 25-A (heading East). Go 2 miles on Route 25-A to the second traffic light. Make a left turn at the traffic light (Wading River-Manor Road). Go one mile to the intersection with North Wading River Road. Make a right turn onto North Wading River Road and go one mile to Little Flower (on left-hand side).
